## Purpose and Audience

The dynamic nature of the HIV epidemic, and the rapidly growing body of information on how it affects women in particular, require providers to update their knowledge on a regular basis. The Colorado Women's HIV Consortium is providing this forum to address the growing impact of HIV and AIDS among women and to promote proper and comprehensive care of HIV-infected women. The target audience includes physicians, nurses, and others caring for HIV-infected women.

## Objectives

- ♀ Review HIV epidemiology in women.
- ♀ Provide HIV treatment update.
- ♀ Identify the potential for drug interactions between HAART medications and addiction treatment, psychiatric and recreational drugs.
- ♀ Explain cardiovascular risk factors in patients with HIV infection.

- ♀ Describe the impact of HIV on immigration status.
- ♀ Summarize travel considerations for persons with HIV.

Free parking is provided in the surface lot east and south of hotel and in the parking structure at the north end of the hotel.

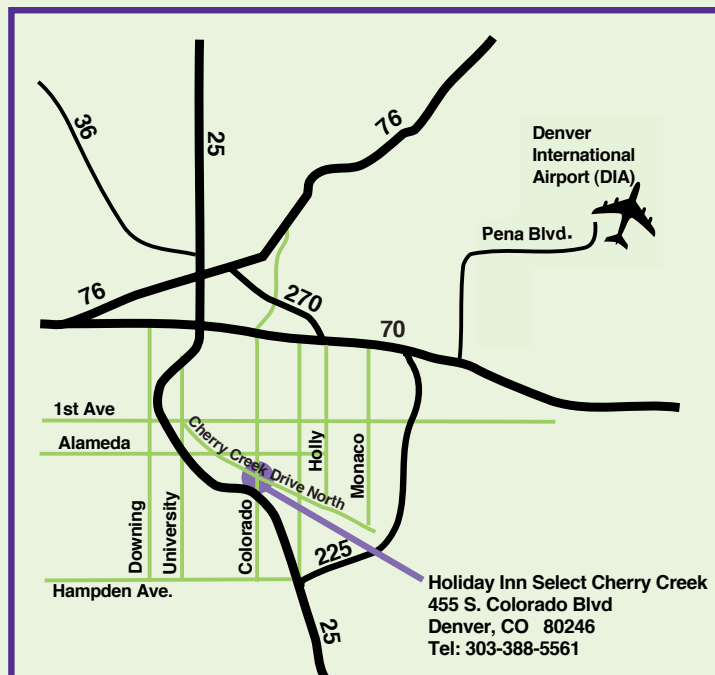
